-we are getting the Cyber Bullying speaker to come back again this year for a daytime talk. We are considering not having a nighttime one because there is another speaker, Tim Hogan, coming in the Spring. We should make it known that there will be an evening presentation, but it will not be until Spring. Tim Hogan shared that the best way to get parents to come is to have it on the same night as another event; tie them together somehow.
